The competition is over 36 holes, medal play with full handicap allowances. The three players with the lowest gross scores will qualify to play at the CSSC Scratch National Championships on 10th September 2008 at Pannal Golf Club. The three players with the lowest net scores will qualify for the CSSC Handicap National Championship on 7th August 2008 at Stoneham Golf Club. **No player can qualify for both championships. You must be in possession of a recognised CONGU (Council of National Golf Club) handicap to play in the finals, and should be a member of a recognised Golf Club. Players in possession of a Golf Society handicap are welcome to play on the day, but are ineligible to play in the national finals. Please note that entries are limited and applications will be treated on a first come, first served basis.**

IMPORTANT: These events are active and players should be aware of the physical activities involved. CSSC reserves the right to cancel the event if under subscribed.

All CSSC members taking part in the event are covered by CSSC Sports and Leisure Public Liability Insurance. Please note that this policy is NOT a Personal Accident Policy. Members are encouraged to take out their own insurance policy.

Play will be in 3 balls and the tee is reserved from 9.30am and 2.30pm. It should take no longer than 4 hours to complete your round. This gives an hour between tee times so it is **VERY** important not to hold up play. Please ensure you are familiar with the rules of golf, if you think your ball may be lost please play a provisional, be ready to play when it is your turn and observe the etiquette of golf at all times. In the event of a tie, the lowest score in the afternoon determines the winner. If this fails to establish a clear winner, the scores from the 18th hole of the PM round will be taken, followed by the 17th in the PM round etc.

The organiser's decision will be final in any dispute. It is not known at the time of writing what subsidy will be available to competitors who qualify for national finals. There will be a 2's sweep with an entry fee of £2.00 per player.

A standard dress code applies at the club of no jeans, collarless shirts etc. Please bring a jacket and tie for the evening presentation, which will be made as soon as possible after the meal, which has been provisionally booked for 8.30pm.

The organiser reserves the right to cancel any event if there are insufficient entries. The organiser's decision on all matters is final. All entries to be received by Friday 30th May 2008.
